

International Staff Officers' Course (ISOC)

AIM

The aim of the course is to enable the students to master the planning and conducting of military operations in accordance with NATO standards throughout the full spectrum of conflicts in multinational environment.

Security Classification:

Unclassified

Target Audience:

Officers in rank of Senior Lieutenant, Captain or Major from all services who are working at company / battalion level appointments or their equivalents.

Training Strategy:

Tuition is conducted daily through lectures, presentations, syndicate discussions, exercises and individual private study (self-study) aimed deepening the knowledge.

There are 6 hours planned daily (1 teaching unit lasts for 50 minutes). The time after lessons is reserved for individual private study (IPS), consultation activities and students' preparation.

Students are divided into 2 syndicates, 10 students each. Education and training is led by ISOC Instructors and Guest Speakers from NATO and the Slovak Armed Forces. It is a residential course with the duration not more than 10 weeks. And it is conducted in two iterations per year.

Depth of Knowledge:

400
